28. It follows a Feb. 26 conference between Barack  
Obama and Panetta. The Senate today voted to end  
U.S. involvement in the war on drugs in the next  
five years. The amendment, spearheaded by Sen.  
Richard Durbin (D-Ill.) and Sen. Jeff Sessions (R-  
Ala.), failed but came within eight votes of passing.  
“This is a historic moment. It is a moment for  
generational change,” said Rep. John Conyers (D-  
Mich.) “We are saying no to a war on our young,  
our families, our homes, our communities and our  
communities. We are saying no to a war on life.” In  
response, House Speaker John Boehner (R-Ohio)  
said, “I’m proud to say that the House will not be  
moving a Durbin amendment.” The Durbin  
amendment would have ended the funding for U.S.  
involvement in the war on drugs and reduced

funding for the DEA. It did not pass, but some Republicans and Democrats said there was agreement that the war should be ended. “It’s time to transition to a policy that is much more drug control-oriented,” said Sen. Dick Durbin (D-Ill.) before the vote. “Instead of a war, we want a war on drug-related violence, on drug-related crime.” Obama said the drug war has not worked, but that the U.S. was “not going to go back to a world where drugs are sold in street markets; where children are trafficked in rural areas; where drug money goes to fund militias and terrorism. We are not going to go back to that world.” “We can take the money from the drug war,” said Conyers, “and put that money into programs that rehabilitate people who have an addiction problem.” At the event, Obama said he would support “all of the reforms that are needed to ensure the DEA goes back to being a law enforcement agency and not a law enforcement agency with teeth.” Rep. Nancy Pelosi (D-Calif.), who chairs the House Democratic Caucus, also said the
